# What Courses do I need?

The following slides will detail by each grade what courses you **MUST** choose because they are grad requirements.

You will need **80 credits** to graduate **AND** the **required courses** (on the following slides).

You also **MUST** complete CLC A and B in grade 11 and 12.

If you did not pass a required course in grade 10 or 11 you **MUST** retake that course, please ensure you choose it.

# Grade 10

You have 6 required courses in grade 10, these are:

1. **Career Life Education 10**
2. **Science 10**
3. **Math 10** (either Workplace Math 10 or Pre-Calculus and Foundations 10)
4. **Social Studies 10**
5. **Composition 10 and one of the strands** - New Media, Creative Writing, Spoken Language, or Literary Studies)
6. **PE 10** (Active Living, Yoga, Fitness and Conditioning, etc.)

\*\* You also need to complete an Arts Education/ADST course for 4 credits as a requirement. This can be at any time in grade 10-12 but most students satisfy this requirement in grade 10 with their elective choice.



# Grade 10

You must take the 6 courses that are outlined on the previous slide.

If you don't choose one of each of those courses it will be added in automatically for you. You might want to choose them instead of us choosing them for you!

The other two courses you need will be electives of your choice.

We will do our very best to get you your top choices of electives but we cannot guarantee your first choices due to several factors (possible need to keep cohorts next year again, availability of the course, number of people wanting the course, etc.).



# Grade 11

You have 5 required courses in grade 11, the other 4 of your courses will be your choice of electives or academics.

1. **English 11** (one of the strands - New Media, Creative Writing, Spoken Language, or Literature)
2. **Social Studies 11** or **12**
3. **Pre-Calculus 11** or **Foundations 11** (if you took Pre-Calculus and Foundations Math 10) or **Workplace Math 11**
4. **Science 11** or **12**
5. **Career Life Connections A (CLC)** - this will be through a google classroom outside of our schedule (on your own time)



# Grade 12

You have two required courses in grade 12, however, you also must have completed all the other required courses and 80 credits of classes (4 credits per class).

1. **English 12**
2. **Career Life Connections B (CLC)** - this will be through a google classroom outside of our schedule (on your own time)

Keep in mind that once your academic requirements are completed, the remainder of your 80 credits will be made up with elective courses, which can be academic focused.

Many students will graduate with more than 80 credits.

Study blocks are only for grade 12 students and can be discussed with your counsellor. Please choose a full course load to start and discuss this after.

Work Experience hours (90 hours) are not retroactive, they begin counting AFTER your workplace is approved by the teacher.
