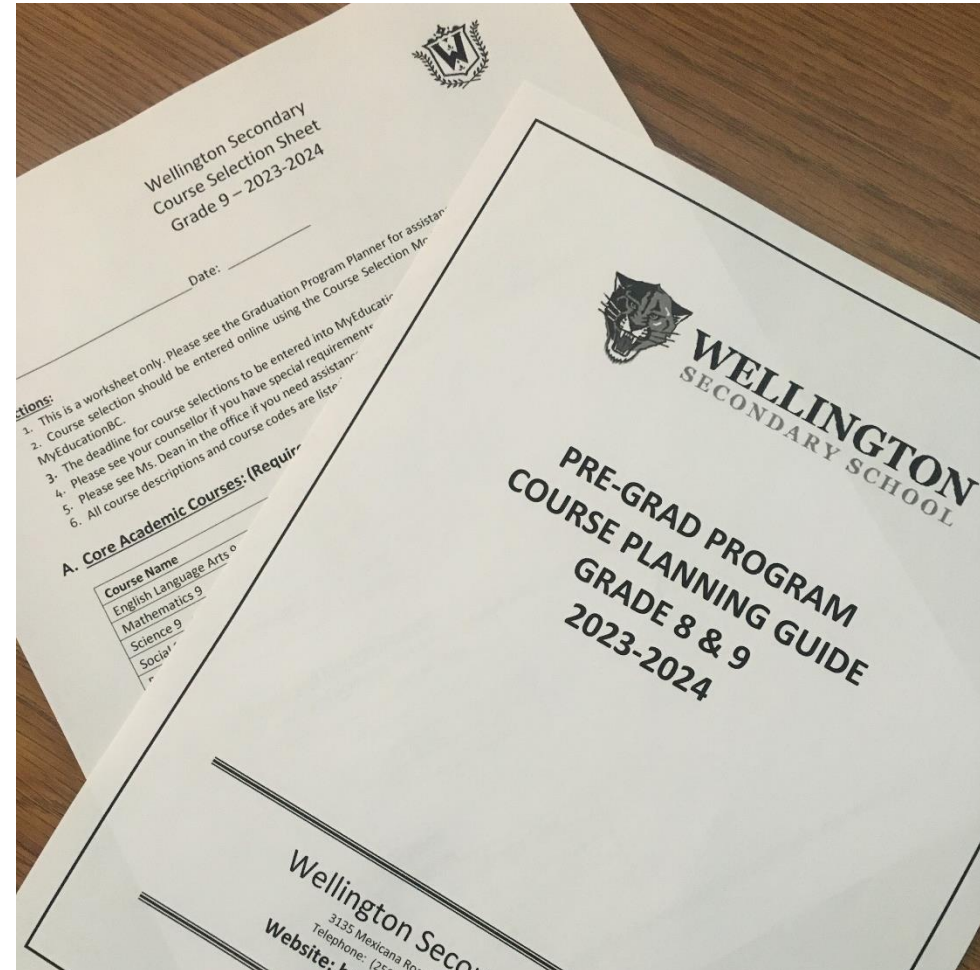

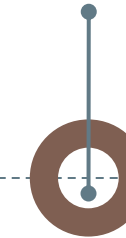

How to Choose Your Courses

- Login to your MyEducationbc Account (s68.#####)
- Click on 'My Info' (top tab)
- Click on 'Requests' (side tab)

How to Choose Your Courses

- Go to “Requests” on the left-hand side of the page.
- Read the instructions.
- Click each of the gray buttons to select courses...
- In Required Courses, select all the courses, then click “OK”.
- In Electives, select 3 courses, then click “OK”.
- In Fine Arts, select any band courses you want, then click “OK”.
- In Alternates, choose 3 courses and click “OK”.
- In the box for “Notes for the Counsellor” add in any specific information counsellors should know about your requests.
- Click the box “Post”. Then log out of MyEducationBC.

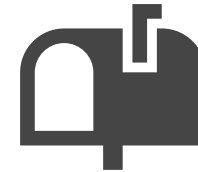
Navigating MyEd 'Request' tab
